THE IMPORTS, EXPORTS AND ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES ACT (Cap 502)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Imports, Exports and Essential supplies Act, the Minister for Commerce and Industry makes the following order:

THE IMPORTS, EXPORTS AND ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES ACT (EXPORT) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) ORDER, 1994

- 1. This order may be cited as the Imports, Exports and Essential Supplies (Export) (Amendment) (No.2) Order, 1994.
- 2. The Imports, Exports and Essential Supplies (Export) Order, is amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and inserting the following:

SCHEDULE

GOODS FOR WHICH AN EXPORT LICENCE IS REQUIRED

- 1. Military equipment and munitions of war
- 2. Engines, vessels, aviation and transportation equipment and motive vehicles possessing or built to current specification differing materially from normal specifications and component or parts thereof
- 3. Antiques and works of art
- 4. Bullions and coins
- 5. Live animals other than livestock and domestic pets
- 6. Archives
- 7. Wood charcoal and timber
- 8. Shells, cowries and corals
- 9. Ivory, rhino horns and other products related to endangered species
- 10. Human bones
