A LAW TO AMEND THE IMPORTS (REGULATION) LAW, 1962.

[23rd February, 1967]

The House of Representatives enacts as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Imports (Regulation) (Amendment) Short Law, 1657, and shall be read as one with the Imports (Regulation) title. Law, 1652 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the repeal Amendment of sub-sections (1) and (2) thereof and the substitution of the following of section 3 sub-section therefor, sub-section (3) thereof being renumbered as of the incipal

Law.

"(1) Whenever it becomes necessary, in the public interest, to restrict and regulate the importation of goods for the encouragement of local production and manufacture, the improvement of the balance of trade, compliance with international obligations or the development of the economy of the Republic, the Minister may, by Order published in the official Gazette of the Republic, restrict and regulate the importation of the goods specified in the Order.".
