

III. SPECIAL EXPORT AND IMPORT PROVISIONS

1. Export and Import Regime for Goods and Services

Article 8

The export and import of goods shall be free (LB).

Notwithstanding the provision of the previous paragraph, the Government of the Republic of Slovenia may, for the implementation of development and protective policy, prescribe that the import and export of specific goods be carried out subject to specified quotas (K).

To fulfil international agreements and other regulations governing the export and import of armaments and military equipment, historical and artistic works, and specific precious metals, specific goods may be exported and imported subject to licence (D). The Government of the Republic of Slovenia may, on the recommendation of the ministry responsible for foreign economic relations, prescribe a procedure for the issue of export licences for the re-export of those goods for which such licences are explicitly required by the country of export.

The classification of goods according to individual import and export regimes (quota, license), the extent or value of quotas, the manner, time period, and conditions for their classification shall be prescribed by the Government of the Republic of Slovenia upon the recommendation of the ministry responsible for foreign economic relations after consultation with the Slovene Chamber of Commerce.

The export and import of services shall be free. Subject to points 1 and 2 of the third paragraph of Article 20 of this law, the Government of the Republic of Slovenia may also prescribe special conditions and criteria for the imports of services.
