# COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS NO. 14 of 2003

#### ORDER

MADE by the Minister under section 4(1) of the Supplies Control Act, (Chap. 20:01).

(Gazetted April 3rd, 2003)

WHEREAS it is provided in section 4(1) of the Supplies Control Act that the Minister may by Order -

- (a) prohibit absolutely the importation or exportation of goods of any class or description from or into any country;
- (b) prohibit the importation or exportation of goods of any class or description except under the authority of a licence issued by the Controller;
- (c) control the prices at which goods of any class or description may be sold whether by wholesale or retail;

AND WHEREAS the Minister desires to prohibit the importation of the goods set out in Schedules I and II to this Order except under the authority of a licence issued by the Controller;

NOW THEREFORE, I, OSBORNE RIVIERE, Minister for Foreign Affairs, Trade and Marketing do order as follows -

1. This Order may be cited as the -

## SUPPLIES CONTROL (RESTRICTED IMPORTS AND EXPORTS)

Interpretation.

2. For the purpose of the Order -

- (a) "Member State of the Caribbean Common Market (CARICOM)" means -
  - (i) Antigua and Barbuda;
  - (ii) Barbados;
  - (iii) Belize;
  - (iv) Grenada;
  - (v) Guyana;
  - (vi) Jamaica;
  - (vii) Montserrat;
  - (viii) St. Kitts and Nevis;
  - (ix) St. Lucia;
  - (x) St. Vincent and the Grenadines;
  - (xi) Suriname; or
  - (xii) Trinidad and Tobago; and
- (b) "Member State of the East Caribbean Common Market of the Organization of the Eastern Caribbean States (OECS)" means -
  - (i) Antigua and Barbuda;
  - (ii) Grenada;
  - (iii) Montserrat;
  - (iv) St. Kitts and Nevis;
  - (v) St. Lucia; or
  - (vi) St Vincent and the Grenadines.

Relief from licence requirements.

3. A person who imports goods from a country which is a Member State of the Caribbean Common Market (CARICOM) shall not require an import licence to import the goods, but the person shall require evidence of origin of those goods in accord ance with the Caribbean Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) Regulations.
