STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS

1992, No. 14

The External Trade (Restricted Imports) (No. 2) Order, 1992 made by the Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of The External Trade Act, Chapter 338.

1. CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT. This Order may be cited as The External Trade (Restricted Imports) (No. 2) Order, 1992, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 2nd day of April, 1992.

2. INTERPRETATION. In this Order -

"the Act" means the External Trade Act, Chapter 338.

3. RESTRICTED IMPORTS. It is hereby ordered that save and except as provided in the External Trade (Restricted Imports) Order, 1992 No. 13, the goods listed in the Schedule shall not be imported without a licence granted under section 4 of the Act.

STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS

1992, No. 13

The External Trade (Restricted Imports) Order, 1992 made by the Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3 of The External Trade Act, Chapter 338.

1. CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT. This Order may be cited as The External Trade (Restricted Imports) Order, 1992, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 2nd day of April, 1992.

2. RELIEF FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT. Save as provided in paragraph 3 of this Order, goods imported from the countries listed in the Schedule shall not require a licence but shall require evidence of origin in accordance with Article 14 of the Common Market Annex to the Treaty of Chaguaramas.

3. EXCEPTIONS. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 2 of this Order, goods imported from the countries listed in the Schedule shall require a licence when these goods either are the subject of an authorisation by the Common Market Council permitting the imposition of quantitative restrictions pursuant to Article 56 of the Common Market Annex to the Treaty of Chaguaramas or are Oils and Fats products traded under Schedule IX to the Common Market Annex to the Treaty of Chaguaramas.
