ORDER

Islamabad, the 4th July, 1995

S.R.O. 607(I)/95.—In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950, (XXXIX of 1950), and in suppression of Ministry of commerce's S.R.O. No. 737(I)/74, dated the 26th July, 1994, the Federal Government is pleased to prescribe the following procedure for the purpose of Implementing the provisions of the said Act and the rules and orders made thereunder:—

CHAPTER - 1

GENERAL

1.1 The registration of Importers and exporters and Issuance of category Pass Books shall be carried out by the Offices of Export Promotion Bureau.

1.2 All Items permissible for import, shall be imported by the registered Importers against letters of credit established by authorized foreign exchange dealers (banks) or against any other mode of payment specified in the Import Policy Order in vogue.

1.3 Letters of credit shall be established and extended by the banks as per provision of Import Policy Order in vogue.

1.4 Import of importable items valuing upto US\$10,000 equivalent shall be allowed against foreign currency demand draft instead of letter of credit.

1.5 For import of items importable subject to certain procedural requirements or conditionalities, all banks shall open letters of credit directly subject to fulfillment of such procedural requirements and conditionalities prescribed in the Import Policy Order. Customs authorities shall also ensure fulfillment of the procedural requirements and conditionalities relating to pre-clearance.

1.6 For import of machinery against cash by commercial Importers, all banks shall open direct letters of credit as per provisions of Import Policy Order.

1.7 For import of machinery against cash for initial installation or expansion and under balancing, modernization and replacement (BMR), all banks shall establish letters of credit for the registered industrial consumers as per their eligibility in accordance with the provisions of the Import Policy Order in vogue.

1.8 Raw Material Replenishment Scheme (RMR) involving import of banned items shall be administered by a committee in the Ministry of Commerce with the representatives from Federation of Pakistan Chamber of Commerce and Industry (FPCC&I) and Export Promotion Bureau (EPB). Pending review of the present procedure, import under RMR will be allowed by Export Promotion Bureau as per specified procedure.

1.9 For import of specified items from India or under any special trading arrangements, banks shall open letters of credit from India or under any special trading arrangements for the specified items only.

1.10 Import of duty free car upto 1300cc by disabled persons will be allowed according to the procedure prescribed by Ministry of Commerce in a Public Notice.

1.11 For import under 'Actual Users' Scheme, banks shall open direct letters of credit for items other than vehicles for war disabled persons as per prescribed procedure. The banks shall, however, open letters of credit on the basis of authorization issued by the Ministry of Commerce for import of vehicles for war disabled persons.

1.12 For import of banned items by public sector organizations, banks shall open letters of credit for the import of these items by public sector organizations on the basis of authorization issued by the Ministry of Commerce.

1.13 For imports under non-Repatriable Investment (NRI) and Pay As You Earn (PAYE) Schemes and Loans and Credits, suppliers' credit imports shall be allowed as per prescribed procedure.

- 1.14 For Imports of arms and ammunition to category holders and members of the Parliament, banks shall open direct letters of credit for the Import of arms and ammunition as per prescribed procedure.
- 1.15 For Import of cars by VIPs, banks shall open letters of credit for the Import of cars by VIPs for their personal use on the basis of authorization issued by the Ministry of Commerce.
- 1.16 For Import of vehicles under Personal Baggage and Gift Schemes, Customs authorities shall release vehicles in accordance with the laid down policy and procedure on the subject.
- 1.17 Import of banned items only without involvement of Pakistan's foreign exchange by foreign construction companies and contracting firms operating in Pakistan, shall be allowed on the basis of authorization issued by the Ministry of Commerce.
- 1.18 Customs authorities shall allow import-cum-export and export-cum-import as per prescribed procedure.
- 1.19 Barter/Border Trade Agreements and Pakistan-Afghanistan Trade Agreements shall be implemented in accordance with the procedure notified from time to time by the Ministry of Commerce.
- 1.20 The refund of import fee shall be made by the EPB's Offices.
- 1.21 No letters of credit shall be established or foreign exchange remitted for goods which have either been shipped or have arrived in Pakistan, except in accordance with the prescribed procedure.
- 1.22 All importers while applying for establishment of letter of credit or effecting imports other than against letter of credit shall produce a valid certificate of membership of at least one of the trade organizations licensed and recognized by the Federal Government.
- 1.23 All imports shall be made at the most competitive prices.
- 1.24 The condition of pre-shipment inspection, wherever applicable, shall be observed.
- 1.25 Change of items in letter of credit shall be made without any charge, provided the items are importable, and the change is made prior to shipment of goods and within the validity of letter of credit.

1.26 All Public Sector Agencies which are allocated specific foreign exchange for Imports by the Ministry of Finance shall use such allocations only for their import requirements.

1.27 Import of second-hand and reconditioned machinery shall be allowed only as per provision of Import Policy Order in vogue, to commercial Importers, Industrial consumers and construction organizations.

1.28 Industrial consumers, construction organizations and engineering concerns shall be eligible to import second hand/used hand tools (hand operated/power driven, etc.) as per provision of Import Policy Order.

1.29 Any letter of credit established or import effected without strict compliance with the requirement of this or any other Order issued by the Ministry of Commerce or on the basis of any false particulars furnished to the banks establishing letters of credit or Customs authorities or Export Promotion Bureau or any other agencies concerned shall be treated as contravention to the provisions of Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950, and rules and orders made thereunder and shall be dealt with accordingly.

1.30 The banks shall ensure without prejudice to the provisions of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950, and any rules or orders made thereunder or any Public Notices issued that there is no contravention of Imports and Exports (Control) Act 1950 and rules and orders made thereunder falling which the dealing bank shall be debarred from opening letters of credit.

1.31 Any matter not covered by the laid down procedures shall be referred to Ministry of Commerce for necessary clarification.

1.32 The import - export procedures shall supplement the provisions of Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950, and rules and orders made thereunder but shall not override such provisions.

CHAPTER - 2

REGISTRATION AS IMPORTERS/EXPORTER

2.1 Application for registration as importer and exporter in Appendix 'A' shall be submitted through banks to the offices of Export Promotion Bureau. Export Promotion Bureau's offices shall grant registration strictly in accordance with the provisions of Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1993.

2.2 The renewal cancellation and suspension of registration as importer or exporter shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the relevant provisions of Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1993.

EXEMPTION FROM REGISTRATION

2.3 In terms of Schedule-I of Import Trade Control Order notified

S.R.O.599(I)/91, dated the 1st July, 1991 and Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1993, the following shall be exempt from registration, namely:-

- I. Import of goods by Federal Ministries and Divisions and their Attached Departments for their own use.
- II. Import of goods by Provincial Government Departments for their own use.
- III. Import of goods as passenger's baggage in accordance with Non-Tourist Baggage Rules and Transfer of Residence Scheme Rules notified by the Central Board of Revenue from time to time.
- IV. Import of goods under Passengers Baggage (Pakistan-India) Rules, 1979.
- V. Import of reading material in terms of Schedule-I of Import Trade Control Order, 1991.
- VI. Import of publicity material in the shape of brochures, posters, calendars, pamphlets and technical literature supplied free of cost.
- VII. Import by Diplomats and Counselors of goods which are exempt from customs duty.
- VIII. Import of goods by Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission, National Logistic Cell, SUPARCO, Director General of Defense Purchases, Director Mechanical Engineering and Stores (Railway) for the use of these organizations.
- IX. Import of goods for mountaineering and by members of trekking expeditions for their own use.
- X. Import under 'Actual Users' scheme as defined in Import Policy Order.
- XI. Importers exempted in term of para 9 of Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1993.

CHAPTER - 3

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF IMPORTS

3.1 A registered Importer who intends to Import any **Importable** Item shall approach any bank for opening of Letter of Credit. For opening of Letter of Credit, the following requirements shall be met generally by the Importers, banks and Customs Authorities, namely :-

(i) By Importers:

- a) To submit application in form Appendix 'B' to the bank;

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- b) To ensure that Imports are being made on most competitive prices;
 - c) To ensure that H.S. Code No. of the items is correct;
 - d) To ensure that import registration and membership of trade body is valid; and
 - e) To obtain necessary authorization from concerned authority where required, before applying for opening of letter of credit.

(II) By banks:

- a) To ensure that importer holds a valid import registration certificate.
- b) The importer has valid membership certificate of trade body.
- c) Necessary endorsement in respect of letter of credit opened has been made in the original category Passbook.
- d) Necessary authorization of concerned authority if required is produced.

(III) By Customs authorities:

To ensure that —

- a) the import of goods has been made as per description and ITC classification mentioned in letter of credit; and
- b) the item is imported in accordance with the procedure prescribed in this Order.

(IV) Import on consignment basis:

Import on consignment basis shall generally be allowed by the State Bank of Pakistan. However, importer and bank in addition to fulfillment of general requirements indicated above shall ensure the following:-

- a) A registered contract for import on consignment basis is submitted by the importer; and
- b) the banks will ensure that the importer submits contract for import on consignment basis.

CHAPTER - 4

**IMPORT PROCEDURE IN RESPECT OF ITEMS SUBJECT TO CERTAIN
CONDITIONALITIES AND PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS.**

4.1 The requirements for the Import of the Items subjected to certain conditionalities and procedural requirements as laid down in the Import Policy Order shall be as under, in addition to general requirements indicated in Chapter 3:-

(a) ITEMS SUBJECTED TO HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS;

b) The Drugs and Medicines imported shall have at least 50 percent of the shelf life calculated from the date of filling of "Import General Manifest" (IGM) as per provisions of Customs Act, 1969.

c) In case of commercial importer, for import of finished drugs registered under the Drugs Act, 1976. Drug retail or whole sale license issued by Provincial Health Department, shall be produced at the time of opening of letter of credit.

5. Waste and scrap in the form of un cut tyres, tubes, plates, and sheets, rubber coated canvas and rubber belting
(H.S.4004.0011).

Release shall be allowed subject to the condition that tyres are cut into pieces.

6. Rubber scrap and cut tyres, tubes, plates and sheets (other than hard rubber)
(H.S.4004.0019).

Release shall be allowed subject to the condition that these are cut into pieces.

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7. Security Paper (H.S.4802.5200)
- (i) Letter of credit shall be established if the Importer produces recommendations of Security Printing Corporation of Pakistan and Pakistan Security Papers.
 - (ii) Importer will produce recommendations of Security Printing Corporation of Pakistan and Pakistan Security Papers.
 - (iii) The release shall be allowed on recommendations as mentioned at (i) above.
8. Maps and hydrographic or similar charts of all kinds including atlases, wall maps topographical plans and globes, printed. (H.S.4905.0000).
- (i) Letter of credit shall incorporate the condition that maps and hydrographic or similar charts of all kinds including atlases, wall maps topographical plans and globes, printed shall define the territories of Pakistan, status of Jammu and Kashmir and the status of the State of Junagarh, Manavader and Mangrol in accordance with the maps published by the Department of Survey of Pakistan.
 - (ii) Release shall be allowed if these maps and charts, etc., are in accordance with the conditions laid down in (i) above.
9. Silver (including silver plated with gold or platinum), unwrought or in semi-manufactured forms or in powder form. (H.S.7106.0000)
- Release of Silver shall be allowed subject to procedure prescribed in the Import Policy Order.
10. Gold (including gold plated with platinum) unwrought or in semi-manufactured forms, or in powder form (H.S.7108.0000)
- Release of gold shall be allowed subject to procedure prescribed in the Import Policy Order.
11. Table, floor, wall, window, ceiling or roof fans, with a self-contained electric motor of an output not exceeding 125 W.
- (i) Letter of credit shall incorporate the condition "not valid for fans above 88 W".
 - (ii) Release of fans above 88 W shall not be allowed.

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12. Specific requirements of oil and gas companies and refineries irrespective of Import status of Individual Items. (Respective Numbers)
- (i) The Importer shall produce recommendations of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Resources/Departments of Petroleum and Energy Resources.
 - (ii) Letter of credit shall be established in accordance with the recommendations of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Resources or Department of Petroleum and Energy Resources.
 - (iii) Release shall be allowed on the basis of recommendations of the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Resources provided that the material and equipment manufactured in Pakistan which carry the certification of American Petroleum Institute (API), shall not be allowed to be Imported.
13. a) Large Agriculture tractors (H.S.8701.9010)
- (i) The letter of credit for Import of tractors in Completely Knocked Down (CKD) shall be established in favour of recognized assemblers only.
 - (ii) Tractors in CKD condition shall be released in favour of recognized assemblers only.
 - (iii) Tractors in Completely Built Up (CBU) condition shall be Imported without the condition of standardization.
- b) Small agriculture tractors/power tillers. (7-15 H.P.) (H.S.8701.9010)
- (i) The letter of credit shall be established in CBU condition only.
 - (ii) Tractors shall be released in CBU condition only.
14. Motor cars and other motor vehicles, principally designed for the transport of persons (other than those specified in heading NO.87.02) including station wagons and racing cars, in CKD condition. (H.S.8703.0000)
- (i) The Importer shall produce deletion programme approved by the Ministry of Industries and Production for progressive manufacturing.
 - (ii) Letter of credit shall be established for items as per deletion programme approved by the Ministry of Industries and Production.
 - (iii) Release shall be allowed for only those items which are importable in accordance with deletion programme.

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15. Three wheeler automotive rickshaws with bodies only. (H.S.8711.0000).
- (i) Letter of credit should incorporate the condition "valid if fitted with 4 strokes engine only."
 - (ii) Release of 3 wheeler automotive rickshaws with bodies only may be allowed if fitted with 4 strokes engine.
16. Aircraft, spacecraft, except aircraft parts. (H.S.8801.0000 to 8805.0000).
- (i) The concerned public sector agency will produce a certificate from the State Bank of Pakistan regarding allocation of foreign exchange for import of the said items.
 - (ii) Private sector airlines, private flying clubs, charter/aviation services and charitable foundations will produce valid licenses from the Ministry of Defense regarding their operation.
 - (iii) Consignment shall be released only if the imports have been effected by the concerned public sector agency or private sector airline, private flying clubs, charter aviation services and charitable foundations.
17. Second hand ships for carrying cargo and passengers, oil tankers and liquid cargo carriers. (H.S.8901.0000).
- (i) The importer shall produce the following namely :-
 - (a) The ship possesses Lloyds certification about its sea worthiness; and
 - (b) the importer shall provide indemnity bond to the effect that if such ship is to be scrapped at any time, he shall report it to the concerned officer of Customs and pay all the import duties and other charges before the ship is condemned for scrap.
 - (ii) The letter of credit shall be established after fulfillment of the conditions prescribed in (i) above.
 - (iii) Release shall be allowed after fulfillment of the conditions prescribed in (i) above.

CHAPTER : 5

CONDONATION OF CONTRAVENTION OF IMPORT POLICY ORDER

5.1 The condonation of contravention of Import Policy Order in respect of importable items involving shipment made from an exporting country before the date of opening of letter of credit or issuance of import authorization or registration of the contract in case of import on consignment basis or any other mode of payment or after the expiry of letter of credit or contract shall be allowed as under:-

5.2 Release instructions in case of import of floating cargo on the high seas shall, however, continue to be issued by the Ministry of Commerce.

CHAPTER : 6

**IMPORT OF BANNED ITEMS FOR PRODUCTION REQUIREMENTS OF EXPORTS
(R.M.R. SCHEME)**

6.1 Various raw materials, the import of which is banned under Import Policy Order but are required for the manufacture of various export products shall be allowed to the extent of their actual requirement determined in terms of percentage of the fob value of the exported products as detailed at Appendix-C.

6.2 Export Promotion Bureau shall issue authorization for import under the scheme.

6.3 Export Promotion Bureau while issuing authorization shall ensure the followings in case of -

(A) Imports against actual exports:

- I. The request for the authorization is received within six months from the date of actual exports alongwith the following documents :-
 - ⇒ Invoice containing "E" Form NO. and date.
 - ⇒ Bill of Lading Indicating "E" Form NO.
 - ⇒ A certificate from bankers of exporters to the effect that goods have actually been exported.
- II. The value of an Item to be Imported does not exceed the percentage mentioned in the Appendix-C.

(B) Advance authorization of Imports to Commercial Exporters:

- I. The Importer submits Indemnity bond or bank guarantee equivalent to C&F value of goods Imported.
- II. In the case, the Importer submits Indemnity bond the goods are kept in a Customs Bonded Warehouse as per procedure notified by the Export Promotion Bureau.
- III. Previous exports liability has been redeemed within one year from the date of Issue of the Import authorization.

(C) Advance authorization of Imports to Industrial Units.

- I. Industrial Units, operating through bond under the Ministry of Finance Notification Nos. SRO 68(I)/70, dated 17.04.1970, SRO 69(I)/70, dated 17.04.1970 and STO 722(I)/89, dated 10.07.1989, shall submit Indemnity bond.
- II. Industrial Unit not operating through Bond, shall submit bank guarantee equivalent to C&F value of the goods Imported.
- III. The procedure notified by the Export Promotion Bureau is followed.
- IV. of previous export liability has been redeemed within 3 years from date of importation of raw material.

6.4 MONITORING:

Monitoring of redemption shall be done by the Customs Authorities only.

6.5 **ADDITION TO R.M.R. LIST;**

For addition of any new Items in RMR list, a Committee set up in the Ministry of Commerce under the Chairmanship of the Joint Secretary (Imports), with representatives from Export Promotion Bureau and FPCCI&I as members shall meet once in every month if need be, to consider such additions. Exporters desirous of inclusion of items of their interest in the RMR list shall apply to this Committee alongwith full justification.

6.6 **RECORDS;**

Record of all exporters utilizing RMR facilities shall be maintained by EPB. Monitoring of indemnity bond and bank guarantees shall also be carried out by Export Promotion Bureau.

CHAPTER : 7

IMPORTS BY PUBLIC SECTOR AGENCIES

7.1 Public sector agencies as detailed in Appendix-D can import all of their requirements which are freely importable against their own foreign exchange allocation.

7.2 Any item of public sector requirement which is otherwise not importable can also be allowed for import by public sector agencies against their own foreign exchange allocation. For this purpose, authorization from the Ministry of Commerce shall be required.

7.3 As regards public sector agencies which are provided specific foreign exchange allocation to meet their import requirements, State Bank of Pakistan will designate a particular bank for each of them to open letter of credit. The banks, however, before opening letters of credit shall ensure that -

- I. the agency has specific valid foreign exchange allocation;
- II. the items to be imported are importable;
- III. In case of banned items, the agency has authorization of the Ministry of Commerce; and
- IV. Import entries are made on the original category pass book only.

7.4 The Customs shall release goods after satisfying that the item is freely importable. In case of banned items, necessary authorization of the Ministry of Commerce be asked for.

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CHAPTER : 8

IMPORTS FROM INDIA

8.1 Import of goods from India (including goods of Indian origin from any country) shall be allowed according to the list at Appendix-E.

8.2 The Importer, bank and the Customs shall ensure the fulfillment of requirements as indicated in Chapter-3 of this Order.

CHAPTER : 9

IMPORT OF MACHINERY

9.1 Only the items enlisted in Appendix 'F' will be allowed for import as machinery in terms of relevant provisions of the Import Policy Order. The items not included in the said Appendix will not be importable as machinery under the Import Policy Order and accordingly shall not be eligible for concessions.

9.2 Machinery items can be imported for the following purposes or categories:-

A) Commercial

B) Industrial:

I. New unit or Initial Installation.

II. Expansion.

III. BMR:

a) Balancing.

b) Modernization.

c) Replacement.

The definition of BMR for the purpose of import of machinery is as under:-

BALANCING

Balancing is taken to mean such equipment as will enable the existing machinery to work up to its capacity and will cover only those items of machinery which help utilization of the existing machinery to such an extent that the increased production is high enough to justify the expenditure of foreign exchange on the import of such balancing equipment.

MODERNIZATION

The term modernization is taken to mean that the equipment for machinery when installed for replacing the existing machinery, or in addition to it, results in better and more economical production and thus reduces the cost of production and provides better amenities to the workers in an industrial unit. "Modernization" may also result in increased production. It may also include machinery for improvement of the quality of products and for imparting better finish to the end products. Humidity and temperature control plants in textile mills should also be considered to be included under the head of modernization.

NOTE:

The import of machinery under balancing and modernization is restricted to back process machinery only. Ring frames for a spinning unit, roter frames for roter spinning and looms for a weaving unit cannot be allowed to be imported under the balancing and modernization. The addition of these machinery always lead to expansion of the unit.

REPLACEMENT:

Replacement means to replace old, and obsolete machinery. According to Import Policy Order replacement can only be allowed if the machinery has attained the qualifying age of 12 years.

Applications for import of machinery by industrial consumers shall be made in the form at Appendix "G" in addition to application at Appendix-B.

9.4 The banks shall open letters of credit for the import of machinery by industrial consumers for new units or for initial installation, expansion and BMR on the basis of information

provided by the importer in his application (Appendix "G"). The importer shall ensure that -

- I. he is entitled or eligible to import the machinery applied for;
- II. the items are importable under the Import Policy Order in vogue;
- III. the purpose for which the machinery is being imported is clearly specified; and
- IV. an indemnity bond is submitted to the customs authorities at the time of clearance so that in the case he is not found eligible or entitled to import the machinery he has imported, he shall pay normal duty leviable on the machinery plus the prescribed penalty.

9.5 The banks before opening letter of credit will ensure that -

- I. The item desired to be imported is included in the list of machinery at Appendix-"F";

- II. the machinery desired to be imported is related to the industrial undertaking of the importer;
- III. the machinery is for the purpose for which it is being imported;
- IV. the machinery desired to be imported is permissible under the Import Policy Order;
- V. the entries regarding import of machinery are made in the original category pass book; and
- VI. the purpose of import of machinery is specified on the letter of credit.

9.6 The Customs authorities will ensure that -

- I. the importer submits indemnity bond at the time of clearance of goods that he would be liable to pay the normal customs' duty on the import of machinery and penalty in case he was not found eligible or entitled to import the machinery;
- II. the machinery imported was strictly in accordance with the Import Policy Order in vogue; and
- III. the customs authorities will also ensure at the time of inspection of machinery's installation that the importer was eligible or entitled to import the machinery and avail the concessions. In case it is revealed on inspection that the importer misused the facility pertaining to import of machinery under initial installation, expansion and BMR, the customs authorities shall charge double the amount of customs duty and sales tax ordinarily leviable on the import of such machinery under intimation to banks and the Ministry of Commerce.

SHIFTING OF IMPORTED MACHINERY:

9.7 The industrial consumers who have imported machinery and millwork for a specified project in a particular area shall not be allowed to shift such machinery to any other project or area without the permission of the Ministry of Commerce.

IMPORT OF MACHINERY BY COMMERCIAL IMPORTERS:

9.8 Commercial importers are also entitled to import machinery items listed in Appendix 'F'. The bank shall ensure that the item for which letter of credit is being established is included in the list of machinery at Appendix 'F'.

IMPORT OF SECOND HAND AND RECONDITIONED MACHINERY:

9.9 Industrial consumers, construction organizations and commercial Importers are allowed to Import second hand machinery. However, the Import of second hand machinery by commercial Importers will be subject to pre-shipment inspection by a recognized International surveyor certifying that the machinery has reasonable useable life.

CHAPTER - 10

IMPORTS UNDER NON-REPATRIABLE INVESTMENT (NRI) SCHEME

10.1 In order to encourage investment in the industrial sector for setting up industries not borne on the list of specified industries' the Government has provided under the NRI Scheme, the facility of importing new as well as secondhand machinery against their own earnings abroad to the Pakistanis residing and working abroad. There will be no restriction on the resale of the machinery after it has been imported.

(i) PROCEDURE FOR IMPORT OF MACHINERY UNDER NRI SCHEME

A Pakistani residing or working abroad will submit application on the prescribed form (specimen at Appendix-I) accompanied with the following documents to the Customs authorities, namely:-

- a) Invoice in respect of machines to be imported;
- b) bill of lading; and
- c) literature about the machines regarding their specifications and performance.

On receipt of the application, the customs authorities, after routine checking and processing, shall allow release of the machinery. Customs shall, however, ensure that machinery imported is covered under the Scheme. Since the price of the machinery imported in this case is paid by the applicant through his foreign resources, no letter of credit shall be established for such imports.

For imports under the said scheme, the applicants themselves need not come to Pakistan. The special power of attorney holder can get the machinery released from Customs against the special power of attorney executed in a foreign country duly attested by the concerned Pakistani Mission. Further more, the power of attorney must incorporate details of machines to be imported.

(II) THE FACILITY OF IMPORTING MACHINERY UNDER NRI SCHEME AVAILABLE TO EXISTING UNITS IN THE COUNTRY.

Existing Industrial units can also Import machinery under the NRI Scheme to expand their existing Industrial concerns. Similarly, the existing Industrial concerns may Import machinery under the said Scheme for balancing, modernization and replacement. The procedure for Import is as under: -

1. The unit in Pakistan will contact a Pakistani residing or working abroad who may be prepared to purchase the desired machinery out of his foreign resources and get it imported into Pakistan.
2. The existing unit in Pakistan will enter into an agreement with the Pakistani residing or working abroad to the effect that the imported machines will be sold to the existing unit.
3. The application for import of the machines shall be made by Pakistanis residing or working abroad. Besides the documents already mentioned in the original copy of the agreement will also be attached to the application form.

(III) MACHINERY SPECIFICALLY ALLOWED UNDER NRI SCHEME

The following machinery has been specifically allowed under the NRI Scheme: -

1. Capital Goods such as combine harvesters, agricultural tractors and implements used for tilling, planting, harvesting and earth-moving specialized vehicles, fishing boats, pleasure boats, green houses, marine engines and accessories, milk collecting lorries.
2. Hotel equipment, buses, trucks, power generators, Aircrafts to bolster service sector. Condition of deletion however, shall be observed where applicable.
3. Surgical Instruments and electromedical equipment imported by doctors and hospitals.
4. Spare parts provided these are imported alongwith the main machine and form part and parcel of the consignment of the said machines.
5. Equipment for Clinical Laboratories (clinical laboratories have been treated as an industry for import under NRI Scheme).

6. Kitchen equipment and machinery or equipment for amusement parks, fun fairs, video games (excluding gambling equipment falling under H.S.Code 9508.0010 and parlour games covered under H.S. Code 9504.9010).

NOTE:. Service and miscellaneous Industry for purposes of Import under NRI Scheme include the following :-

- a) Hotels and Motels.
- b) Building Industry.
- c) Cinema houses and film studios.
- d) Haulage and transport Industry.
- e) Dry cleaning.
- f) Transport.

v) MACHINERY/EQUIPMENT NOT ALLOWED UNDER NRI SCHEME

The following machinery and equipment is not allowed under the NRI Scheme:-

1. The Machinery or equipment import of which has been banned in the Import Policy Order in force, or through orders or instructions made thereunder.
2. Raw Material as well as the components required for the assembly or manufacture of goods.
3. Machinery and equipment for parlour games.
4. Beauty clinics and slimming clinics are not treated as industry for import under the Scheme.
5. Parts and accessories of hand tools imported separately.
6. The Machinery meant for the following specified Industries:-
 - 1) Arms and ammunition.
 - 2) Security printing, currency and mint.
 - 3) High explosives.
 - 4) Radio-active substances.

9. Projects in which more than 60% of the raw materials are importable, provided that the value of such import exceeds 20% of the total investment in fixed assets.

CHAPTER : 11

IMPORT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

IMPORT OF VEHICLES UNDER PERSONAL BAGGAGE/GIFT SCHEME:

11.1 The Customs Authorities shall release vehicles brought under Gift Scheme on the basis of following documents:-

- I. Prescribed application form duly filled in by the applicant alongwith required documents; and
- II. gift undertaking duly endorsed by the concerned Pakistani Missions abroad. The donee himself shall present the documents personally except in case of females where Power of Attorney shall be acceptable.

IMPORT OF VEHICLES UNDER PERSONAL BAGGAGE SCHEME:

11.2 The Customs authorities shall release vehicles brought under Personal Baggage Scheme on the basis of the following documents:-

- I. Prescribed application form duly filled in by the applicant alongwith required documents; and
- II. Original Passport alongwith a photocopy. The original shall be returned after necessary endorsement therein. The Importer shall personally present the documents to the Customs authorities.

11.3 Customs Authorities would ensure that vehicles are Imported strictly in accordance with the provisions of Personal Baggage and Gift Scheme (Import of Cars, Buses, Trucks and Light Commercial Vehicles) Order, 1993.

CHAPTER : 12

REFUND OF IMPORT FEE AGAINST EXPORTS

12.1 The exporters are eligible to claim refund of import fee paid on Imported raw materials consumed in the manufacture of various export products, within six months from the date of exportation or the date of issue of the Public Notice Issued by Export Promotion Bureau notifying the rates of certain commodities whichever is later.

12.2 According to the procedure, the refund is to be allowed on the basis of rates already notified by the former CCI&E and in future be notified by the EPB/Ministry of Commerce from time to time. To claim import fee refund, the

eligible exporter will submit his application on the prescribed form (Appendix 'J') to the EPB alongwith the following documents:-

- I. Shipping invoice duly certified by the Customs;
- II. Copy of shipping bill duly certified by the Customs;
- III. Bill of Lading and Airway Bills;
- IV. Export Proceeds Realization Certificate; and
- V. A copy of Form 'E' duly attested by the concerned bank.

12.3 In the event of an exporter claiming refund fraudulently or by mis-declaration he shall be served a notice to show cause for the recovery of the refunded amount and imposition of penalty. If the exporter is found guilty, a penalty upto 10 times the amount claimed may be imposed without prejudice to any other action which may be taken against the exporter under the Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1993.

12.4 No claim of refund shall be admissible after 393 days from the day, the Import fee was abolished i.e., 9.6.1994.

CHAPTER : 13

BANNED ITEMS

13.1 All Items set out in the Table of Chapter-4 of Import Policy Order are banned for Import unless specifically authorized by the Ministry of Commerce.

13.2 The Importers, bankers and the Customs shall, however, ensure that no Import is effected of the following:-

- a) Translation of the Holy Quran without Arabic text;
- b) goods (including their containers) bearing any words or inscription of a religious connotation, the use or disposal of which may injure the religious feelings of any sect, class or group in Pakistan;
- c) goods (including their containers) bearing any obscene pictures, writings, inscriptions or visible representations;
- d) horror comics, obscene and subversive literature and anti-Islamic literature;
- e) Second hand commodities or reconditioned goods or factory rejects and goods of job lot or sub-standard quality, except second hand or reconditioned machinery and millwork; second hand tools (hand operated or power driven); moulds and moulding dies; second hand ships for carrying cargo and passengers, oil tankers and liquid cargo carriers; second hand or used aircrafts and helicopters; second hand armoured security vans; used or second hand books, magazines and journals; used or second hand

clothing including footwear; used or second hand travelling rugs and blankets and waste, second and cutting of -

- (i) Iron and steel (excluding stainless steel) sheets and plates in cut length or coils minimum width 50.8 cm (20-Inches) and minimum length 121.9 cm (48 inches);
 - (ii) Tin sheets or plates of one side not less than 45.7 cm (18-Inches); and
 - (iii) stainless steel sheets or plates;
- f) any goods containing ingredients or parts which may be repugnant to the injunctions of Islam as laid down in the Holy Quran and Sunnah of the Holy Prophet (Peace be upon him), including products and by-products of pigs, hogs, boars or swine;
- g) dyes based on benzidine or containing it; and
- h) hazardous wastes as defined and classified in Basal Convention (details are at Appendix-D of the Import Policy Order, 1995).

CHAPTER 14

IMPORT AND EXPORT AUTHORIZATION

14.1 Ministry of Commerce shall issue import and export authorization in respect of the following:-

- (a) Import authorization in respect of -
 - I. motor cars imported by disabled persons as per recommendations of a High Powered Board; and
 - II. Import of arms and ammunition by members of the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies.
- (b) Import-cum-export authorization in respect of goods imported by foreign air companies.

Provided that authorization under this category is subject to the condition that an indemnity bond equal to the value of goods imported on temporary basis will be submitted to the customs authorities at the time of release of consignment.

- (c) Import-cum-export authorization in respect of banned items in respect of -
- i. goods imported by oil prospecting companies and service companies contracted by oil prospecting companies.
- Provided that authorization under this category is subject to the condition that an Indemnity Bond equal to the value of goods imported on temporary basis will be submitted to the customs authorities at the time of release of consignment.
- (ii) goods imported by foreign construction companies/foreign contracting firms for various projects in Pakistan.
- Provided that authorization under this category is subject to the condition that 100% bank guarantee equivalent to the value of items are submitted to the customs authorities at the time of release of the consignment ensuring that the goods will be re-exported.
- (d) Any other item for which authorization for import or export or import-cum-re-export or export-cum-re-import is required.

14.2 Authorization of the Ministry of Commerce shall be issued on letter-head of Ministry of Commerce, consecutively numbered and embossed.

CHAPTER - 15

IMPORTS UNDER LOANS, CREDITS AND BARTERS:-

15.1 Import Procedure in respect of Imports under Loans, Credits, Suppliers' Credit, PAYE Scheme and Barter shall be as under: -

(i) Imports under Suppliers' Credit and PAYE Scheme:

Bank or a DFI shall open letters of credit on the basis of contract, between the supplier and the importer, duly registered with State Bank of Pakistan.

(ii) Commodity Loans:

Loans which were previously disbursed by the Office of the CCI&E would be utilized only through a bank or a DFI designated by State Bank of Pakistan for this purpose for a particular loan.

(iii) Project Loans:

For the disbursement of project loan provided by International donor agencies such as IDA, IBRD, ADB, IDB etc. State Bank of Pakistan shall designate a commercial bank or a DFI to disburse each kind of loan mentioned above.

(iv) Barter:

The banks and the DFIs shall open letters of credit as per procedure to be notified by the Ministry of Commerce from time to time.

15.2 The above shall be in addition to the procedure contained in Chapter-3 of Order.

CHAPTER : 16

ITC CLASSIFICATION:

16.1 Any dispute over classification of an item shall be referred to the Ministry of Commerce for decision.

CHAPTER : 17

IMPORTS WITHOUT INVOLVEMENT OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE OF PAKISTAN

17.1 Import on permanent or on temporary basis where no foreign exchange of the country is involved shall be allowed in accordance with the following procedure :-

(a) Import on permanent basis by Pakistani nationals and companies:

The customs authorities shall release consignments on the basis of the following, namely :-

- (i) The items must be importable, and
- (ii) In case the items to be imported are in commercial quantity, the importer shall submit valid import registration.

(b) Import of banned Items on permanent basis by foreign construction companies and foreign contracting firms

Ministry of Commerce shall Issue authorization on the basis of the following :-

- (i) The Items are either to be consumed on the project or become permanent fixtures of the project; and
- (ii) the request has been endorsed by the concerned Government agency.

(c) Import of banned Items on temporary basis by foreign construction companies and foreign contracting firms

Ministry of Commerce shall Issue authorization on the basis of the following :-

- (i) The Items are neither consumed in the execution of the project nor can become permanent fixtures of the project; and
- (ii) bank guarantee equivalent to the value of the items are submitted to the customs authorities at the time of release of consignment ensuring that the goods will be re-exported.

(d) Freely Importable Items on permanent basis by foreign construction companies and foreign contracting firms

The customs authorities shall release consignment on the basis of the following, namely :-

- (i) the Items are Importable;
- (ii) the Items are either to be consumed on the project or become permanent fixtures of the project; and
- (iii) the request has been endorsed by the concerned Government agency.

(e) Freely Importable Items on temporary basis by foreign construction companies and foreign contracting firms

The customs authorities shall release consignment on the basis of the following, namely:-

- i) The Items are Importable;

- (ii) the items are neither consumed in the execution of the project nor can become permanent fixtures of the project; and
- (iii) bank guarantee equivalent to the value of the items are submitted to the customs authorities at the time of release of consignment ensuring that the goods will be re-exported.

(f) Import of vehicles and other items donated or gifted to various local social welfare organizations, hospitals, charitable institutions and Government organizations not exempt under the Import Trade Control Regulations.

The Customs authorities shall release consignments on the basis of the following, namely:-

- (i) The Importers are charitable institutions or social welfare organizations registered under the relevant law, and recognized hospitals;
- (ii) the items are importable;
- (iii) the items to be imported are not in commercial quantity;
- (iv) the items so imported shall exclusively be used by the importer;
- v. In case of non consumable items, prior permission of the Ministry of Commerce would be required for their disposal;
- (vi) cars shall not be allowed to be donated or gifted to charitable organizations or welfare institutions, etc.;
- (vii) the donations to charitable organizations or welfare institutions should be in the form of buses, mini-buses, coasters, pick-ups, station wagons, vans and 4X4 wheel drive vehicles which are suitable for the hilly terrain and for the rural areas;
- (viii) the request for import of donated or gifted items must be supported by the administrative Ministry or the Provincial Government concerned.

(g) Imports by industrial units, for test, trial and maintenance.

The Customs authorities shall release the machinery items, components, parts and accessories thereof imported by industrial units of the country for test, trial and maintenance of the existing unit on the following

conditions, namely:-

- i, the unit is registered with the Export Promotion Bureau as an Industrial unit;
 - ii, the Items are Importable; and
 - iii, the Imported Items are not in commercial quantity.
- (h) Permanent retention of goods Imported on temporary basis.

Ministry of Commerce shall authorize retention of goods Imported on temporary basis, on the following grounds:-

- i, Items are Importable; and
- ii, Customs-duty and sales tax leviable at the time of Import are paid.

CHAPTER : 18

REPLACEMENT OF GOODS FREE OF COST BY PAKISTANI EXPORTERS DURING THE WARRANTY PERIOD.

18.1 The Customs Authorities shall allow Pakistani exporters to replace the exported goods found defective during the warranty period without charging any cost from the Importer subject to the following:-

- a) Original/copy of the contract showing warranty period.
- b) Any communication from foreign Importer to the effect that certain goods from the exported consignment have been found defective.

18.2 Exporter will, however, not be eligible for duty drawback against the goods exported as replacement of defective goods.

CHAPTER : 19

EXPORT OF GOODS

19.1 Export of goods from Pakistan is allowed generally. However, export of some items is banned, restricted or is subject to certain conditionalities as provided in the Export Policy Order. For that, export in case of live animals and meat shall be in accordance with the procedure notified by Export Promotion Bureau from time to time.

19.2 Export of bonafide accompanied personal baggage will be permissible without any authorization by any Government agency. The customs authorities will ensure that no banned or restricted item is taken out from the country as accompanied personal baggage.


19.3 Export of unaccompanied personal baggage except banned or restricted items shall be subject to export authorization issued by the Export Promotion Bureau.

CHAPTER : 20

EXPORT-CUM-IMPORT

20.1 Customs Authorities shall allow export-cum-import in case of repairs or replacement of the items imported, subject to the following conditions :-

- I. The applicant submits indemnity bond assuring that the goods will be re-imported after repairs or replacement, as the case may be;
- II. no additional cost in foreign exchange is incurred by the applicant;
- III. In cases of repairs involving remittance, the customs authorities shall allow re-import subject to production of no objection certificate from the State Bank of Pakistan;
- IV. In case of export of vehicles for the purpose of carrying 'Zalreen' to various Holy places, the Export Promotion Bureau shall issue authorization for export-cum-import of the vehicles in accordance with the procedure notified through a public notice on the basis of guarantee issued by Automobile Association of Pakistan or West Pakistan Transport Mutual Assistance Co-operative Society Ltd.
