Subject: Mandatory Philippine National Standards

 In accordance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 133, series of 1987, of R.A. No. 4109, the manual tory implementation of standards for the following products is hereby ordered, for the protection consumers:

PNS 74/UL1570 - Specification for Fluor Lighting Fixtures - Safety and Performance 1.2 PNS 100 ments for Liquefied Petrol Stove for Household Use - Specification for Safety 1.3 PNS 130 Automotive Application - Safety Requirements PNS 134 Electric Fans 1.5 PNS 137 - Packaging and Labeling Requirements for Toys - Dimensions & Tolerances for 1.6 PNS 173 Timber - Specification for Lighting 1.7 PNS 189 Sets Using Miniature and Sub-Miniature Lamps for Decorative Purposes PNS 194 - Specification for Sawn Timber / 1.8 1.9 PNS 196 - Specification for Plywood 1.10 PNS/DOT 3,4,5 - Specification for Motor 'Vehicle Brake Fluid

2. All manufacturers, distributors, importers and retailers of the above-mentioned products shall comply with the requirements of said national standards.

- 3. A third-party certification, known as the PS Quality Certification Mark, shall be obtained from the Bureau of Product Standards (BPS) by all manufacturers concerned. Importers of the above-mentioned products shall acquire a commodity clearance from the BPS, as a pre-requisite of import shipment release by the Bureau of Customs.
- 4. The BPS shall promulgate implementing guidelines specifying implementing timetables, taking into consideration present inventory levels, production capabilities of industries, and testing capabilities of BPS and other testing institutions. When necessary, BPS may designate an appropriate, competent organization to assist in various aspects of standards implementation work (such as product inspection, testing, market monitoring) for specific products.
- 5. The implementation of all of these standards shall be done in coordination with the DTI Regional and Provincial Offices and the Bureau of Domestic Trade Regulation and Consumer Protection.
