SUPPLIES AND SERVICES ACT (CAP. 117)**Importation (Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Supplies and Services Act, the Minister for Development of Tertiary Sector has made the following regulations:—

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Importation (Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990 and shall be read and construed as one with the Importation (Control) Regulations, 1969, hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

Citation and commencement.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st January, 1991.

2. For the Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following new Schedule:
